Ladies and Gentlemen:

**RESOLUTION REGARDING 911 POLICY OF PSC DEPARTMENT  
(REQUEST TO SEND OFFICERS TO SCHOOLS IN CERTAIN SITUATIONS)**

**WHEREAS**, it is desirable to have the Brown County Public Safety Communications Department (PSCD) request that law enforcement be sent to schools in Brown County whenever a 911 call is received by the PSCD from a land-line phone at a school in Brown County and the caller hangs up prior to providing information to the PSCD; and

**WHEREAS**, it is also desirable for law enforcement to provide education regarding the 911 process in general to schools located within Brown County.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Brown County Board of Supervisors that it shall be the policy of the PSCD to request that law enforcement be sent to schools in Brown County whenever a 911 call is received by the PSCD from a land-line phone at a school in Brown County and the caller hangs up prior to providing information to the PSCD; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Brown County Board of Supervisors hereby requests that law enforcement agencies that operate within Brown County provide education regarding the PSCD 911 process to schools located within Brown County.

*Fiscal Note: This resolution does not require an appropriation from the general fund. The County Board does not have authority to require law enforcement officers to respond to a 911 center request for officer dispatch.*
