



PROHIBITED ITEMS IN THE COURTHOUSE

People entering the Brown County Courthouse Complex should feel safe to attend to their matters within the facility and a screening process is necessary for that purpose. The Brown County Courthouse Complex has adopted the policy that all people and items entering the facility are subject to search and certain items will be prohibited from entering. Prohibited items include, but are not limited to:

- Firearms, pellet guns, BB guns or replica firearms
- Ammunition
- Knives, Box cutters, razor blades, edged weapons and sharp-pointed objects
- Club-like items (e.g., batons, baseball bats, golf clubs)
- Martial arts weapons
- Brass knuckles
- Mace, pepper spray, or other chemical agents
- Electric weapons
- Skateboards, roller blades or roller skates, bicycles, and mopeds
- Any intoxicating beverage (unless prior approval received for events) or illegal drugs
- Flammable or explosive materials
- Tools unless the person is an authorized contractor
- Any equipment, apparatus, or machine failing to comply with local fire codes, unless exempt, or property that if utilized would interfere with an electrical or mechanical building system without permission from Facility Director
- Other items that could pose a danger to others
- Other items that could disrupt court proceedings
- Excessive amounts of bags, purses, backpacks, etc

Please return any of the above items back to your home or vehicle. A disposal box is available for items that are surrendered, and items will not be returned.
