An important update: Brown County Public Health (BCPH) intends to create a COVID Response Team (CRT) as of July 1, 2021 and end our official COVID-19 Incident Command Structure. This document will continue to be shared every other week and will include updates regarding all areas of Brown County Public Health in addition to the COVID-19 updates.

Goals of the Incident Command COVID-19 Response through July 1, 2021

- Slow the spread of COVID-19 in Brown County to minimize illness and death.
- Keep Brown County open using proactive prevention efforts.
- Promote both community and internal resiliency and recovery efforts.
- Ensure Brown County residents have access to COVID-19 vaccine in a timely and equitable manner.

Successes/Milestones this week

- Over 41,000 COVID-19 vaccine doses have been given at Lambeau Field Mass Vaccination Site.
- Held a vaccination clinic in partnership with Casa Alba and N.E.W. Community Clinic at St. Willebrord's Catholic Church on May 22-23. 320 vaccine doses were given at this two-day clinic.

A press release was also sent out.• Finalized the contract with Green Bay Metro Transit to transform one of their buses into a mobile vaccination clinic.• Held a press conference on Thursday May 20 with several community partners to discuss the importance of getting vaccinated.

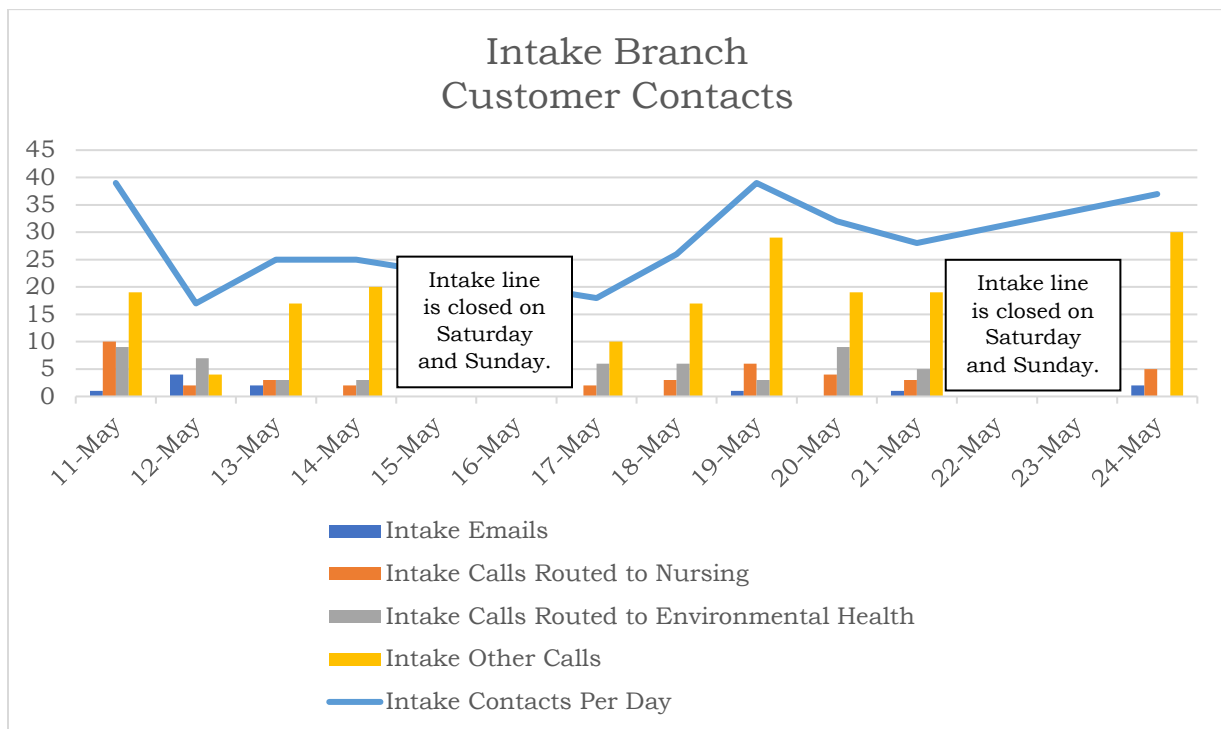
Vaccination Planning: Biweekly Summary

<p>Internal Vaccination Efforts and Processes</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A meeting was held to discuss process improvement regarding WIR entry. The identified improvements will be applied to clinic processes moving forward and will have a real-time trial run on May 22nd and 23rd at the St. Willebrord's Parish clinic. • The development of the mobile vaccination clinic was finalized and the process to wrap the bus is expected to be complete by May 28th. The bus will be operational as of June 1st following the Memorial Day Holiday.
<p>Vaccination Partnerships and Planning</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On May 17th BCPH participated in a meeting with NEW CC, St. Willebrord's Parish, and Casa Alba to discuss the upcoming second dose clinic to be held on May 22nd and 23rd. The discussion centered around the idea of supplying first doses of the Pfizer vaccine for anyone who comes to the second dose clinic. The decision to supply everyone with the opportunity to be vaccinated while providing information on where to obtain a second dose when applicable was made. • The Saint Willebrord's Parish second dose clinic successfully administered 320 doses.
