- Developed a data management plan to capture critical data to help identify trends in COVID-19 data.

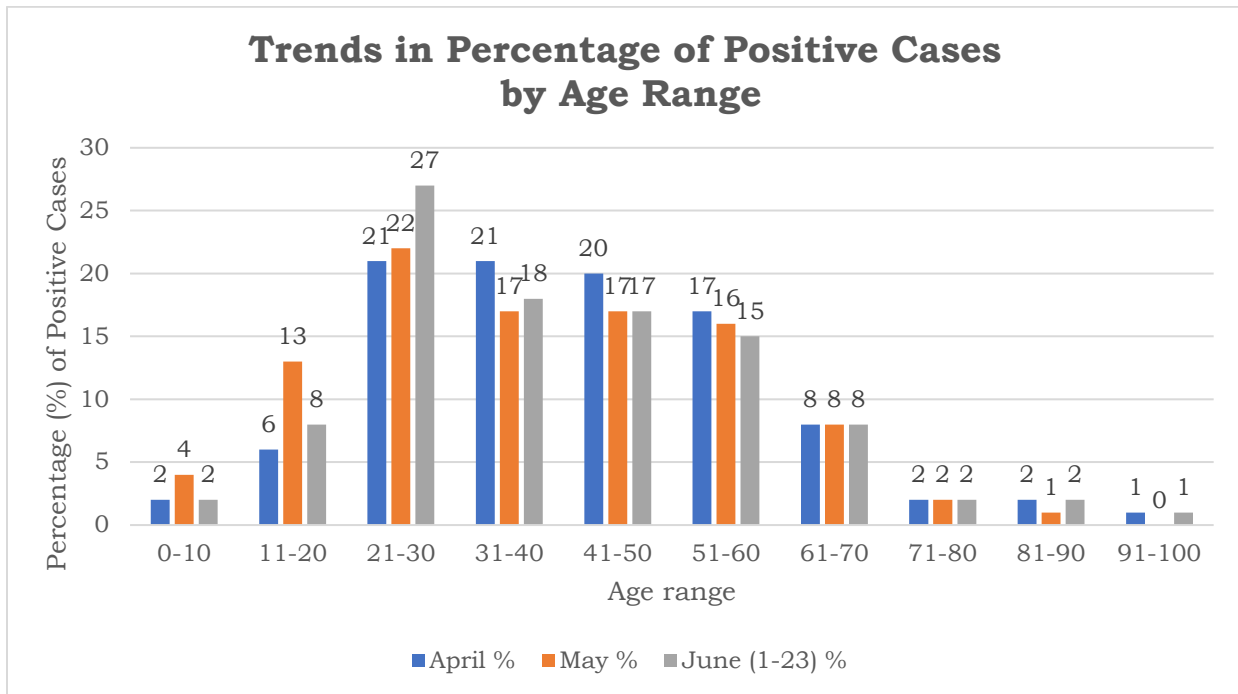

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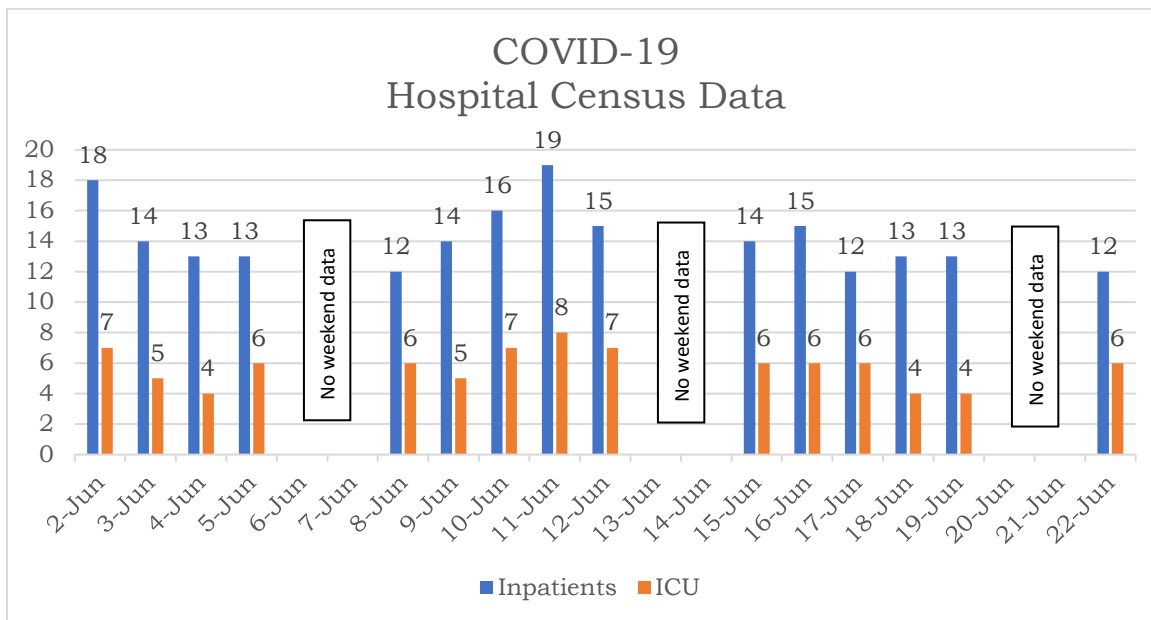


Note: We have seen a general increase in positive cases in the 21-30 age range. This has been identified as a priority area for outreach.

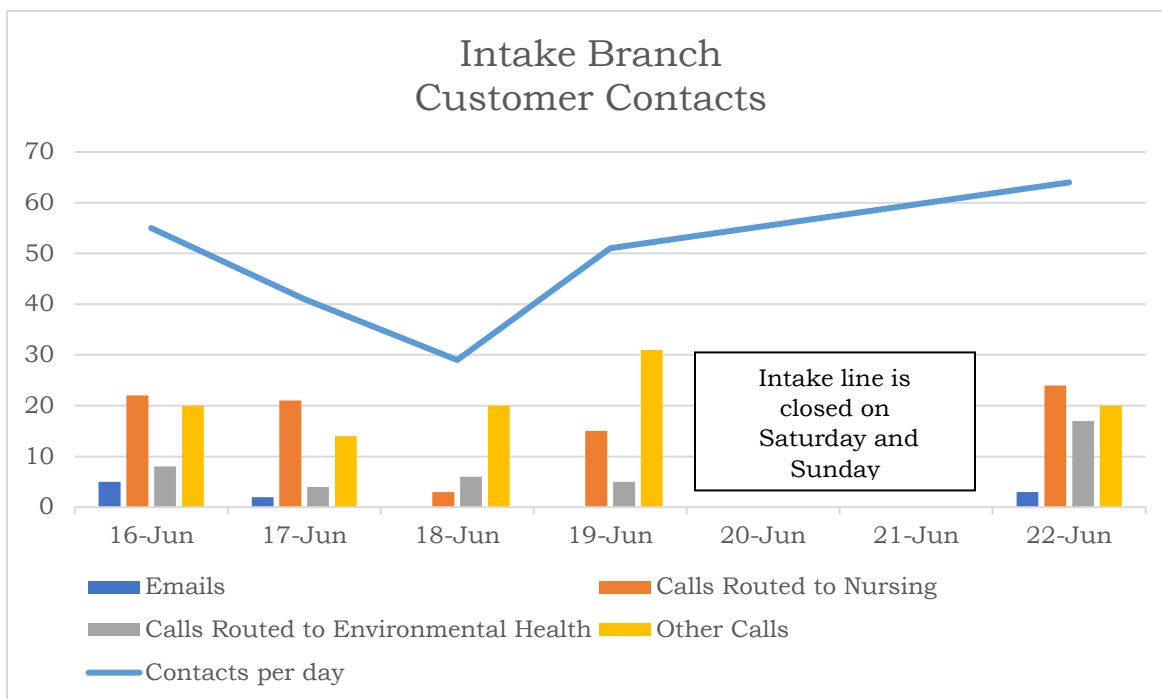
