- Enhanced data collection methods and received clarification from DHS on reports to improve consistency of shared reporting measures.

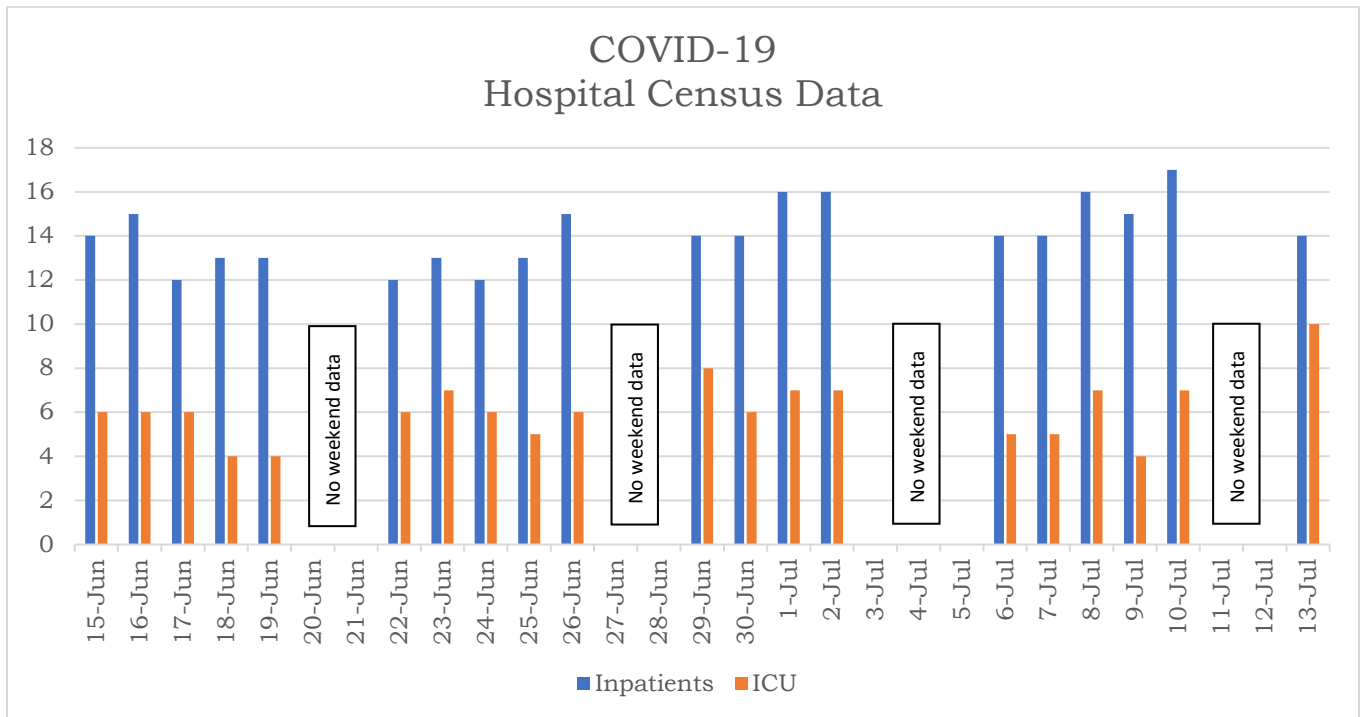

Compiling and critically analyzing current data sources	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Researched methods of reporting done at DHS level and cross-compared data to ensure accuracy in reporting. • Customized template report from partnering local health department, Winnebago, for more robust data collection. • Utilized CDC template to assess current trends in zip code of positive cases (see graph below).

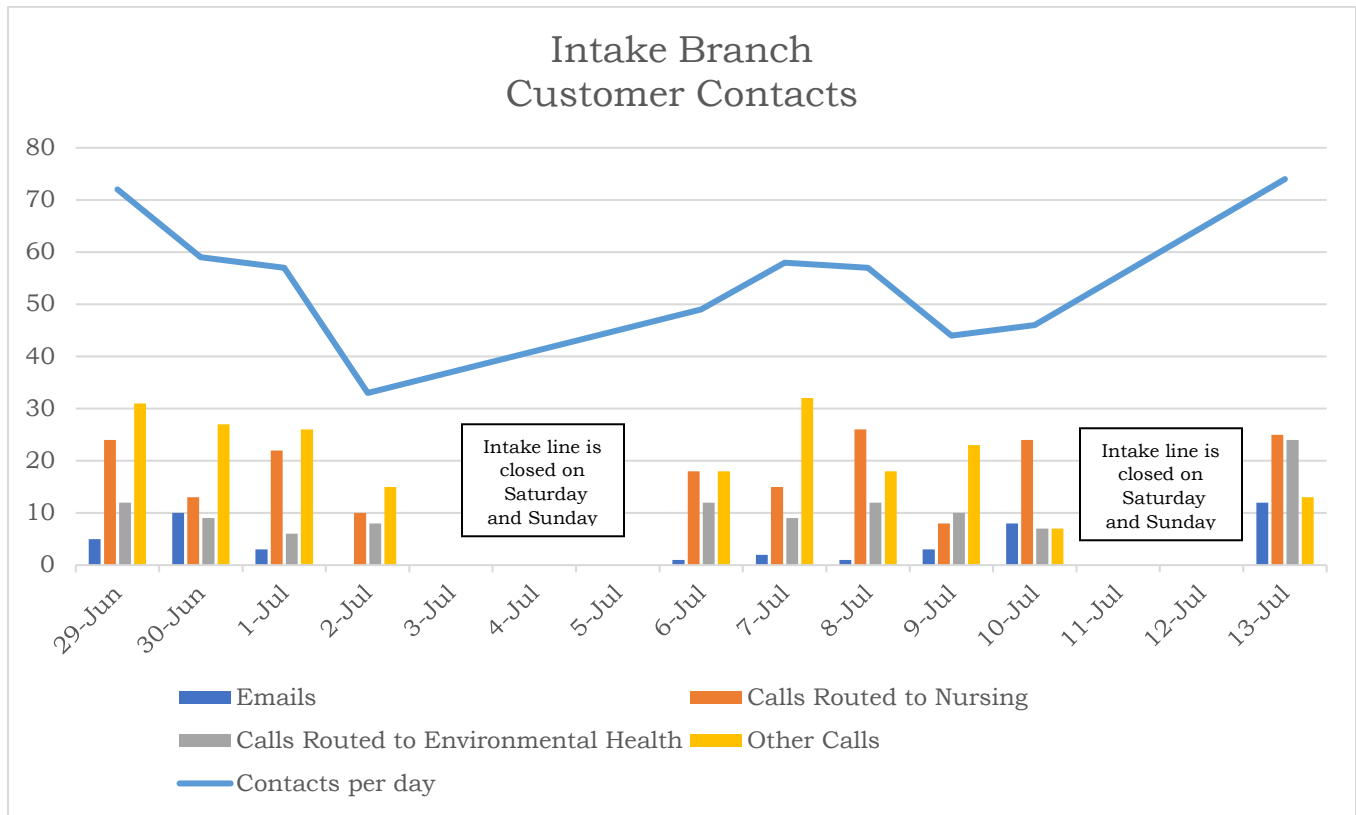

Masking Ordinance Customer Contacts from 7/7-7/13

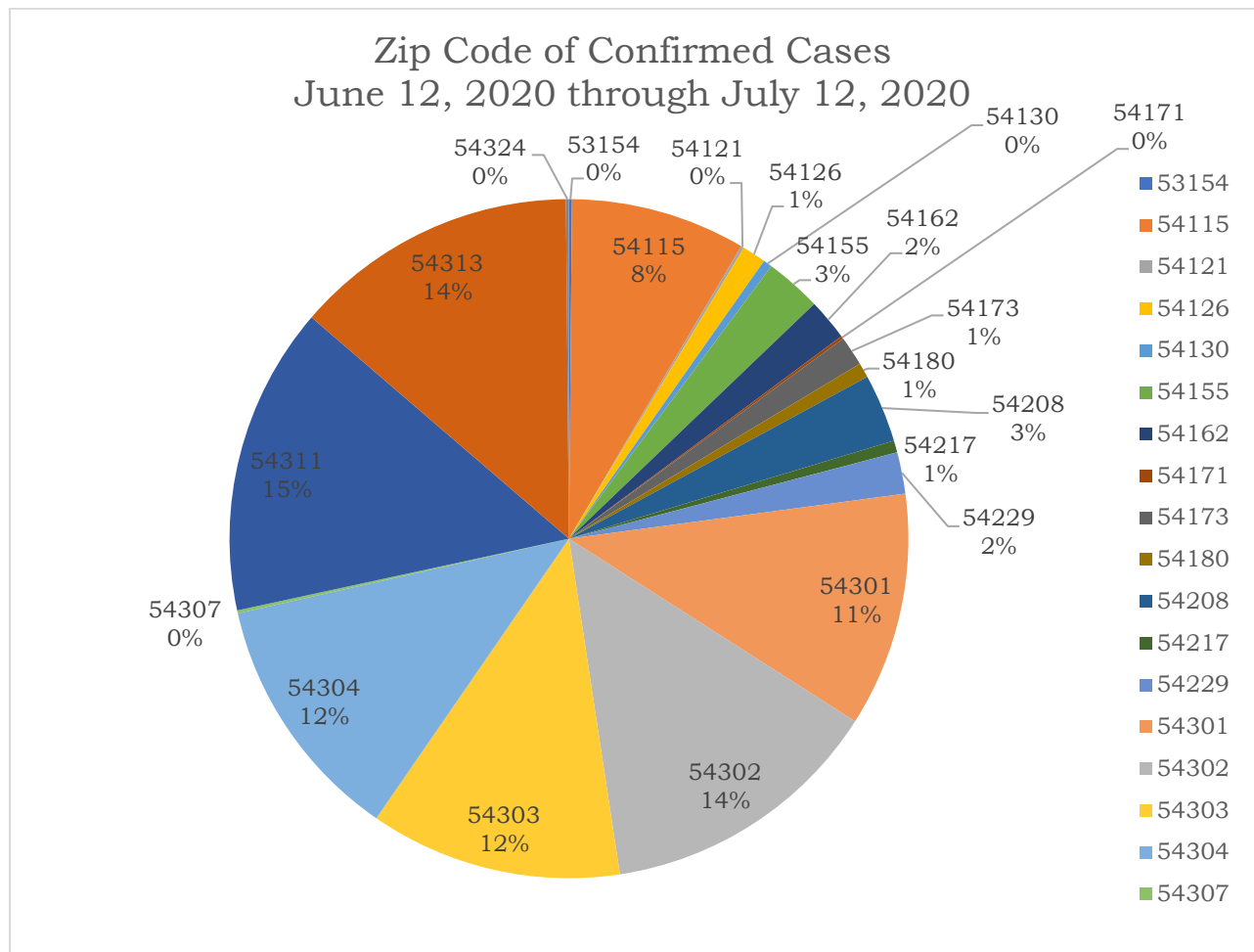
