RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
BROWN COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION
ADOPTING NATIONAL HIGHWAY SYSTEM (NHS) PAVEMENT AND BRIDGE CONDITION
PERFORMANCE MEASURE TARGETS FOR 2023-2025

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Transportation established performance measures for the assessment of pavement and bridge conditions on the National Highway System (NHS); and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) established statewide targets for pavement and bridge conditions on the NHS in accordance with federal law; and

WHEREAS, Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs) must establish targets for pavement and bridge conditions on the portions of the NHS within their Metropolitan Planning Areas; and

WHEREAS, MPOs establish NHS pavement and bridge condition targets by either agreeing to plan and program projects so that they contribute to the accomplishment of WisDOT's statewide pavement and bridge condition targets or commit to developing quantifiable pavement and bridge condition targets for the Metropolitan Planning Area.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Green Bay MPO agrees to plan and program projects that contribute toward the accomplishment of WisDOT's 2022 - 2025 NHS pavement and bridge condition targets for the following performance measures:

NHS Pavement Condition Targets

Measure	Baseline (2021)	2-Year Target (2023)	4-Year Target (2025)
Interstate – Percentage of pavements in "Good" condition	65.9%	> 60.0%	> 60.0%
Interstate – Percentage of pavements in "Poor" condition	0.3%	< 4.0%	< 4.0%
Non-Interstate NHS – Percentage of pavements in "Good" condition	36.3%	> 30.0%	> 30.0%
Non-Interstate NHS – Percentage of pavements in "Poor" condition	4.2%	< 10.0%	< 10.0%

NHS Bridge Condition Targets

Measure	Baseline (2021)	2-Year Target (2023)	4-Year Target (2025)
Percentage of NHS bridges by deck area in "Good" condition	51.3%	> 49.0%	> 48.0%
Percentage of NHS bridges by deck area in "Poor" condition	2.6%	< 3.0%	< 3.0%
