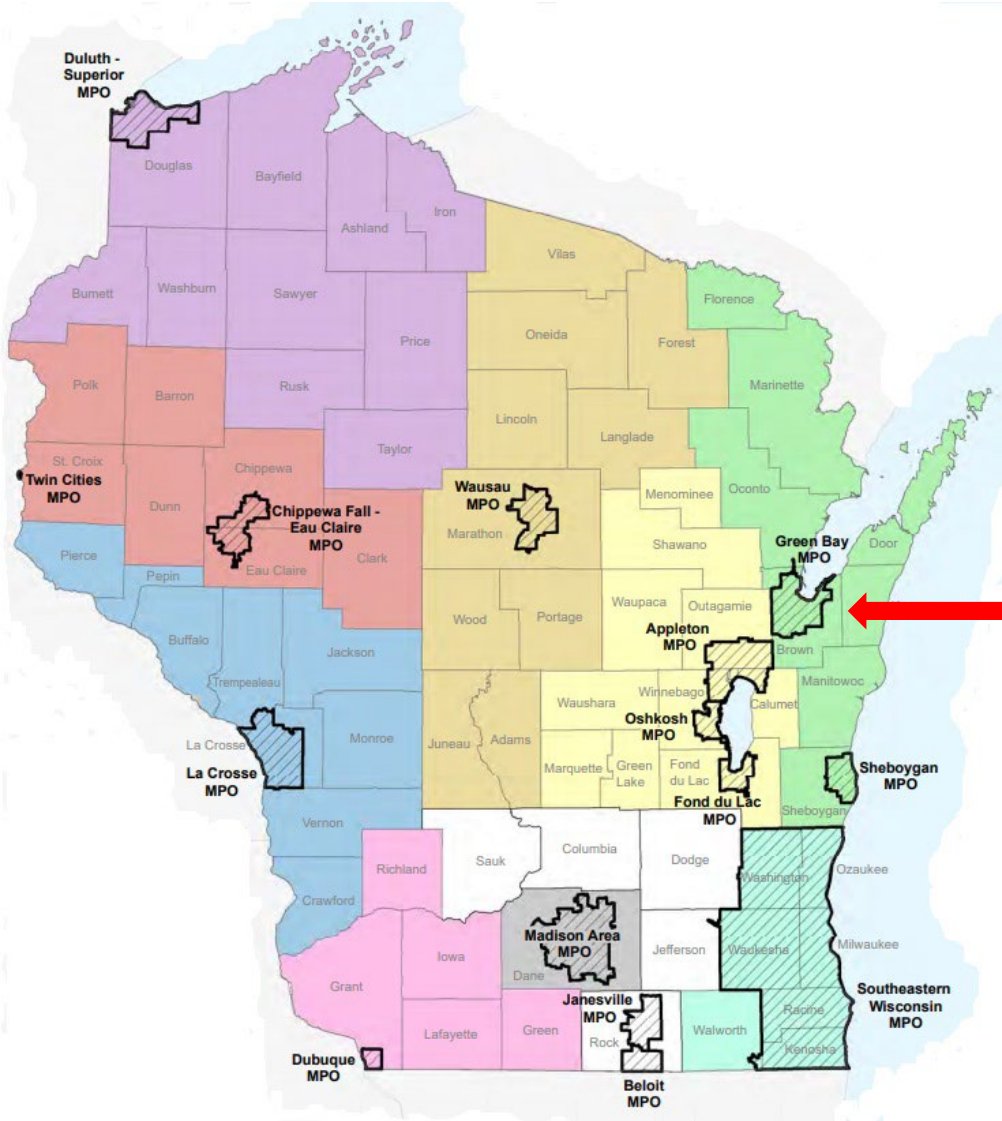
What is an MPO?





- A **Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO)** is an organization that carries out the metropolitan transportation planning process in an urbanized area.
- An urbanized area with a population of at least 50,000 persons is required to be represented by an MPO. (U.S. Census Bureau - decennial census).
- An urbanized area with a population over 200,000 persons is designated as a **Transportation Management Area (TMA)**.

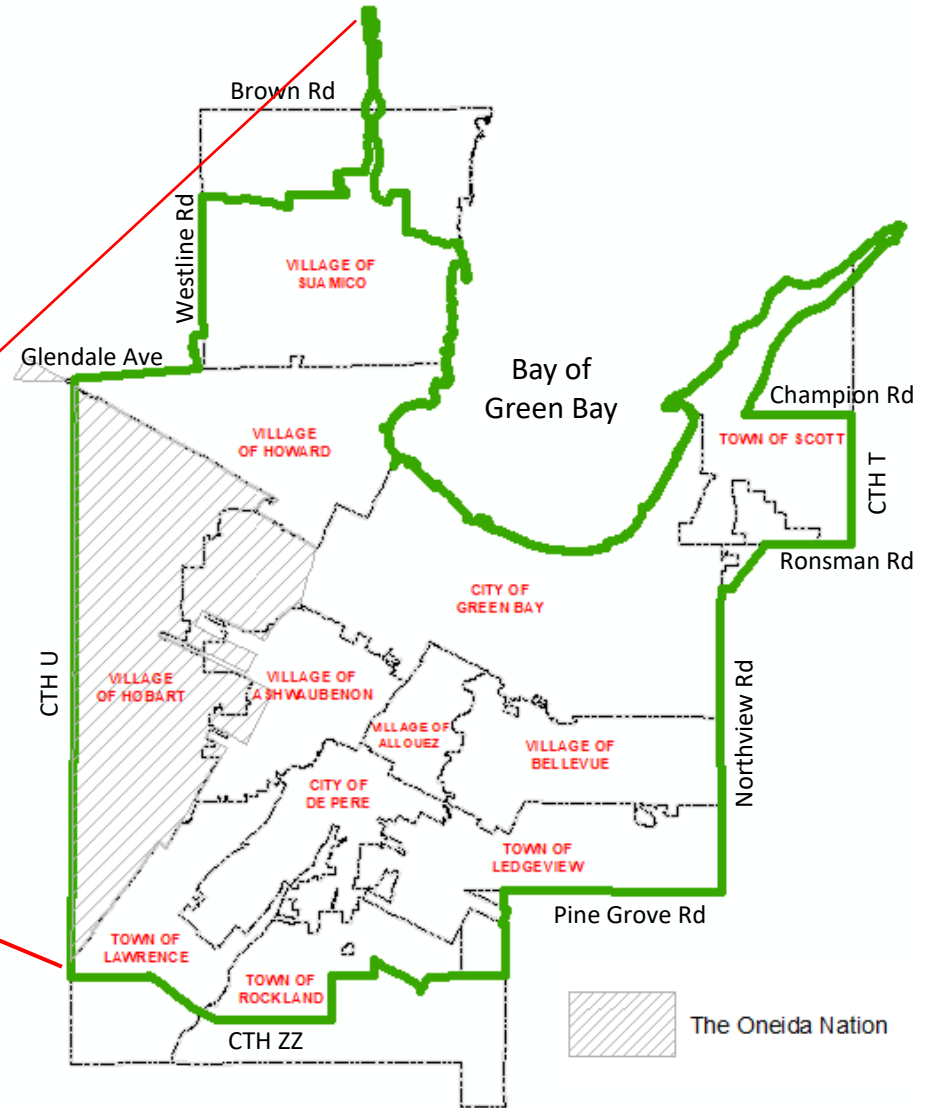
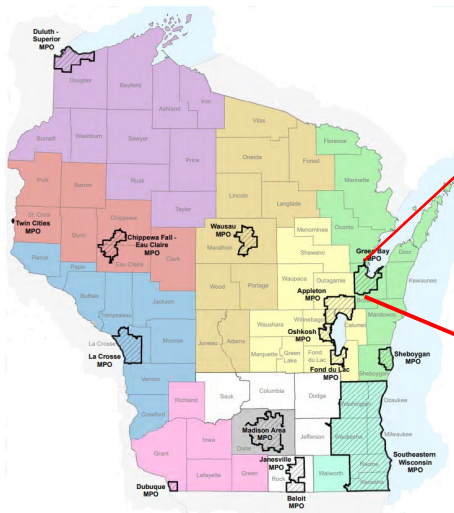
14 MPOs in Wisconsin

History

- Designated as the **Green Bay Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO)** in January of 1974.
- In July of 2012, the Green Bay MPO was designated as a **Transportation Management Area (TMA)** since its population was greater than 200,000 people.
- The Green Bay MPO is housed within the **Brown County Planning Commission.**

Board of Directors



- **Brown County Planning Commission Board of Directors** is the Green Bay MPO's Policy Board.
- **28 appointed members** that represent every municipality in Brown County, the BC Board of Supervisors, WisDOT, and Green Bay Metro Transit.

MPO Advisory Committees



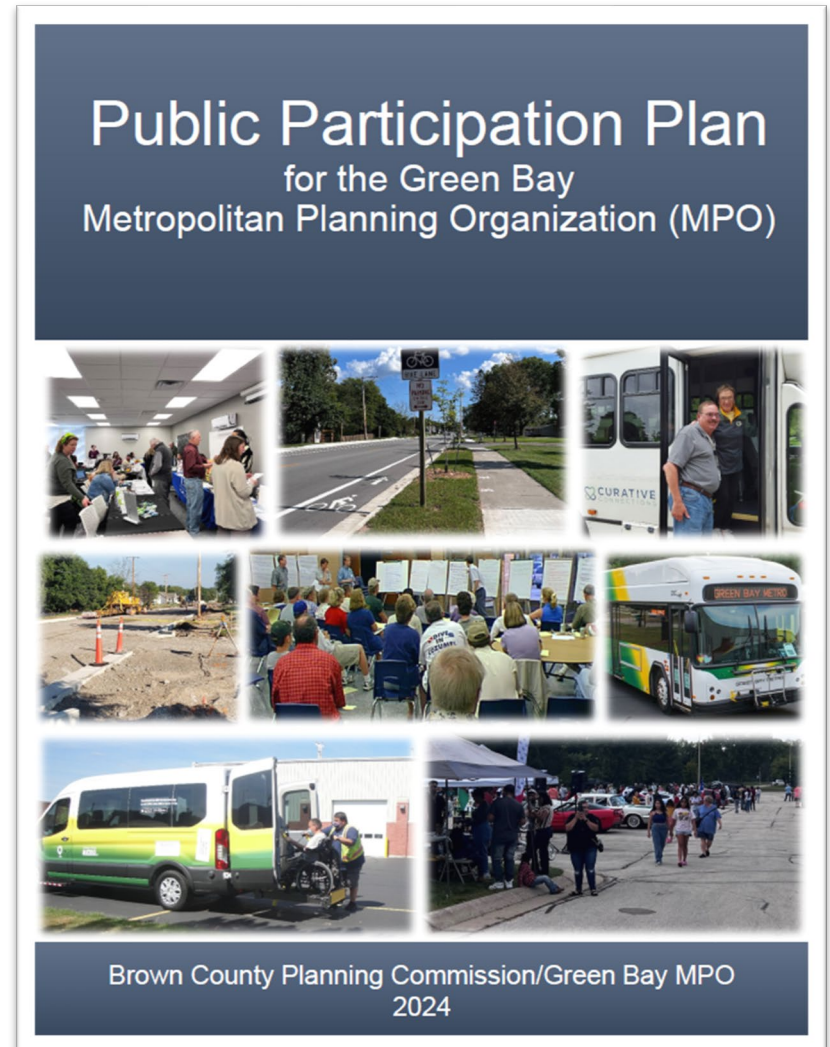
- **Transportation Subcommittee (TS)**

Core Function

- Establish and manage a **fair and impartial** setting for effective regional decision-making regarding transportation planning.
- Evaluate transportation issues and needs across all modes within the Green Bay Metropolitan Planning Area.
- Develop and maintain a **Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP)**.
- Develop and maintain a **Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)**.
- Outreach to and engagement of the general public.

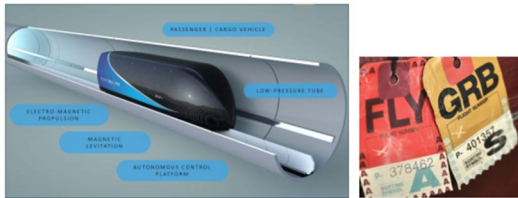
Public Participation Plan
