A Certificate of Compliance must be submitted to this office before occupancy for any habitable structure within 20 feet of a critical slope or on a critical slope.

The undersigned hereby makes application for a shoreland permit for the premises described above. The undersigned agrees that all permits and approvals will be obtained prior to the start of any development. Development shall be completed in compliance with Chapter 22 and Chapter 23, Brown County Code, and all other applicable local, county, and state codes and ordinances. Issuance of this permit does not release the applicant from the responsibility of obtaining any other permits that may be required. This permit is valid for two years from the date of issuance.

Wetlands Notice to Permit Applicants - You are responsible for complying with state and federal laws concerning the construction near or on wetlands, lakes, and streams. Wetlands that are not associated with open water can be difficult to identify. Failure to comply may result in removal or modification of construction that violates the law or other penalties or costs.
