All –

We've reviewed our costs associated with making sandbags. **We'll be adjusting our prices effective July 1, 2020.**

The sandbags will continue to be made at our main highway shop in Howard (Duck Creek Center @ 2198 Glendale Ave.)

If your municipality needs sandbags:

1. **During work hours call Heather at 662-2160. In an emergency (after hours), call the on-call Superintendent anytime day or night at 391-4699.**
2. **Costs: The cost for 1 full sandbag is \$2.25 per bag (\$112.50 per pallet of 50) – these are pre-filled by County staff and on pallets ready for pickup. If you bring good quality wood pallets to replace the ones going out, the cost for 1 full sandbag is \$1.50 per sandbag (\$75 per pallet of 50).**
3. **If a landowner in your municipality needs sandbags, Brown County will sell them to the municipality and the municipality can decide how to serve their citizens (we are serving you as a municipal entity). So to be clear, private citizen requests for sandbags need to flow through the municipality.**
