Meeting Minutes from June 14, 2022

Judge Hock calls the meeting to order at 12:18 p.m.

New Business:

- A) New Grant Applications: Grant request from City of De Pere for crowd control equipment. County Executive Streckenbach joins meeting at 12:27 pm Motion by Sheriff Delain and seconded by David Lasse to approve the \$4,200 grant request for City of De Pere. Chief Muraski abstains from vote. **Motion carried unanimously.**
- B) Media events to promote grant applications. Chief Muraski states City of De Pere has a media specialist who could assist in creating a public safety announcement. District Attorney Lasee states he reached out to United Way and they could share a video or information with other non-profit groups to educate them about the grant opportunities. Judge Hock inquires if the neighborhood watch groups were contacted. District Attorney Lasee states the same contact works with the City of Green Bay and their neighborhood groups. County Executive Streckenbach suggests going back and reviewing past grant awards which had a positive impact on the community and develop a story to promote future grant opportunities. Chief Muraski to follow up with the media specialist and County Executive Streckenbach indicates Jeff Flynt can assist. Michelle Wallerius to provide a listing of past grant recipients.
