I. **Call Meeting to Order:**

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Norb Dantine at 6:00 p.m.

II. **Approve/Modify Agenda:**

Motion made by Supervisor Erickson and seconded by Supervisor Fleck to approve the agenda. MOTION APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY

III. **Approve/Modify Minutes of Land Conservation Subcommittee of March 23, 2009:**

Motion made by Supervisor Fleck and seconded by N. VandeHei to approve the minutes. MOTION APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY

IV. **Set Date and Time for May Meeting (currently falls on Memorial Day:**

Because the usual meeting date for this committee falls on Memorial Day, a recommendation was made to change the date to Tuesday, May 26th. Supervisor Fleck also suggested that during the months of May through September, meetings be held at 7 p.m.

Motion made by Supervisor Erickson and seconded by Supervisor Fleck to set the May meeting for Tuesday, May 26th, 2009 at 7 p.m. Summer hours will continue from May through September. MOTION APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY

1. **Budget Status Financial Report for March 31, 2009:**

No questions were asked. Recommendation made to approve.

Motion made by Supervisor Erickson and seconded by Supervisor Fleck to receive and place on file. MOTION APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY

2. **Request for Budget Transfer (#09-24): Increase in Expenditure with Offsetting Increase in Revenue: Transfer for Soil and Water Resource Management Cost Share Funding:**

Bill Hafs explained that this budget transfer will adjust the 2009 budgeted DATCP Soil & Water Resource Management line items to reflect final grant allocation from the State – a decrease of \$48,116.

Motion made by Supervisor Erickson and seconded by Supervisor Fleck to approve. MOTION APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY

3. **Additional Grant Funding from NRDA Funds for West Shore Pike Habitat Restoration Project:**

Jim Jolly reported that he was contacted by the Fish & Wildlife Service indicating they will provide \$200,000 for the continuation of the current Suamico/Little Suamico Watershed Pike Habitat Restoration Project. \$180,000 will be used for cost sharing practices, and \$20,000 for staff.

(Supervisor Kaster arrived 6:04 p.m.)

Motion made by Supervisor Erickson and seconded by Supervisor Fleck to approve. MOTION APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY

4. **Grant Application Review (#09-19) re: West Shore Pike Habitat and Baird Creek Habitat Protection Project:**

Hafs explained that this grant will pay 100% for staffing, computers, travel costs, educational materials, and cost share for landowners for habitat restoration projects on West Shore & Baird Creek. The grant is for \$250,147 over two years or (\$500,474 total).

Technicians will contact landowners to sell the need for conservation installation on private land and in Baird Creek. \$150,000 will be used as an incentive to expand buffer strip width from 35' to 100' at \$1,000 per acre. In the West Shore project, \$439,000 will be used from Natural Resources Damage Assessment funds as an incentive for landowners to restore wetlands, install buffer strips, correct culvert elevation problems prohibiting northern pike migration, and to improve streambanks.

Motion made by Supervisor Haefs and seconded by Supervisor Kaster to suspend the rules to allow interested parties to speak. MOTION APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY

Steve Lambert – Representing Baird Creek residents

Mr. Lambert stated he and other Baird Creek residents are in support of this project.

Motion made by Supervisor Erickson and seconded by Supervisor Kaster to return to regular order of business. MOTION APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY

Motion made by Supervisor Erickson and seconded by Supervisor Fleck to approve. MOTION APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY

5. **Letter from Brown County on Cuts in State Funding for Land Conservation: (Attached: Joint finance Budget and Compliance Letter with Chapter 92 with attached petition; b) Lena Taylor Senator correspondence):**

Mr. Hafs referred to packet material in regards to budget concerns for Land & Water Conservation. Distributed and attached is a "Conservation Funding Petition" signed by over 100 persons petitioning the Governor and the State Legislature to fully fund County Land & Water Conservation Department staffing at 100% for the 1st employee, 70% for the 2nd employee, and 50% for all additional staff as identified in State Statute 92.14 (6), changing the wording from "shall attempt" to SHALL.

Hafs explained that Brown County Land & Water Conservation Department staff work on a number of activities including state mandated conservation programs, protection of surface and groundwater, conservation compliance protecting agriculture from liability and improve agriculture economic profitability and projects that improve sustainability, energy, and promote tourism.

Motion made by Supervisor Erickson and seconded by Supervisor Kaster to receive and place on file. MOTION APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY

6. **Director's Report:**

Hafs highlighted the following activities during the last reporting period:

- 21,000 trees have been sold
- Animal waste information distributed

Brown County Farm Bureau has addressed an issue discussed in January regarding a property owner building a feed lot too close to a property line. This will be distributed to land owners in the future. The update includes "friendly reminders" to include the following:

- To implement best management practices on farming operations.
- To follow a 590 Nutrient Management Plan addressing fertilizer and nutrient needs for cropland.
- To contact the LCC office if planning a building project
- To watch the weather forecast in regard to spreading manure
- To keep an eye on manure pits to avoid overflow
- To be aware of proper manure spreading procedures

Motion made by Supervisor Erickson and seconded by Supervisor Kaster to receive and place on file. MOTION APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY

7. **Such other matters as authorized by law: None**

Motion made by Supervisor Kaster and seconded by Fleck to adjourn at 6:20 p.m. MOTION APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY

Spring Update

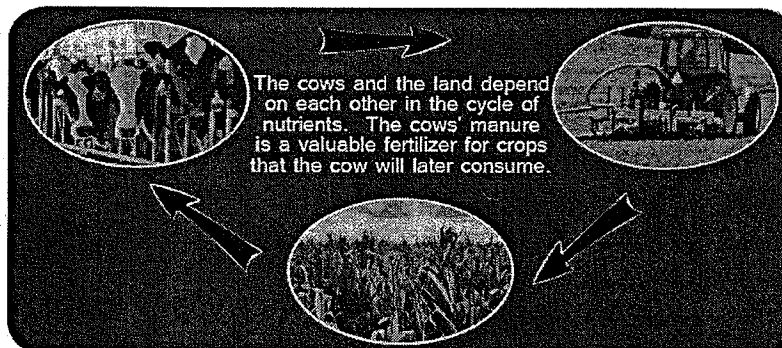


With warm weather around the corner, the Brown County Farm Bureau would like you to keep in mind some simple things that you can do to be a good farmer and neighbor.

Friendly Reminders.....

- **Implement best management practices (BMP)** on your farming operations.
- **590 Nutrient Management Plans (NMP)** – Following a 590 plan will help you to address your fertilizer and nutrient needs for cropland. Applying the correct amount of fertilizer will save you money! Contact your agronomist or local cooperative to help you develop a NMP.
- **If you are planning a building project**, be sure to contact the Brown County Land and Water Conservation Department at (920) 391-4620.
- **Watch the weather forecast** – sudden warm weather creates spring thaws and hi-risk times for spreading manure.
- **Keep an eye on your manure pit** to avoid overflow.
- **If you work with a custom manure applicator**, make sure they are aware of proper spreading procedures and your 590 plan.
