3. Director's report. Receive & place on file.

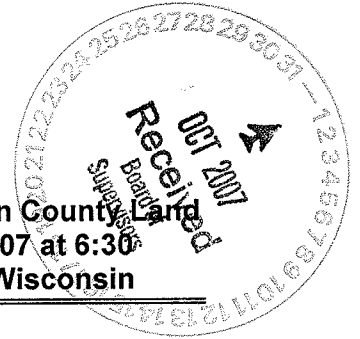

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE BROWN COUNTY
LAND CONSERVATION SUBCOMMITTEE**



Pursuant to Section 18.94 Wis. Stats., a regular meeting of the Brown County Land Conservation Subcommittee was held on Monday, September 24, 2007 at 6:30 p.m. in Room 161, UW-Extension, 1150 Bellevue Street, Green Bay, Wisconsin

1. **CALL MEETING TO ORDER:**

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Dantinne at 6:45 p.m.

2. **APPROVE/MODIFY AGENDA:**

A MOTION WAS MADE BY SUPERVISOR FLECK AND SECONDED BY SUPERVISOR ERICKSON TO APPROVE. VOTE TAKEN. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

3. **APPROVE/MODIFY MINUTES OF LAND CONVERSATION SUBCOMMITTEE OF AUGUST 27, 2007.**

A MOTION WAS MADE BY SUPERVISOR VANDER LEEST AND SECONDED BY SUPERVISOR FLECK TO APPROVE. VOTE TAKEN. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The minutes were modified with the following changes:

- 1) August 27, 2007 minutes (#1) should be meeting called to order by Chairman Dantinne.
- 2) August 27, 2007 minutes (#4) motion seconded by Supervisor Erickson.
- 3) August 27, 2007 (#8) motion made by Supervisor Vander Leest.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY SUPERVISOR ERICKSON AND SECONDED BY SUPERVISOR VANDER LEEST TO APPROVE MINUTES AS MODIFIED. VOTE TAKEN. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

4. **VARIANCE REQUEST BY JEFF BORCHARDT, 4575 WAYSIDE ROAD, GREENLEAF, TO CONSTRUCT A MANURE STORAGE FACILITY CLOSER THAN 250 FEET FROM PROPERTY LINE. (MAPS AND SUPPORTING INFORMATION WILL BE AVAILABLE AT MEETING.)**

Jon Bechle, Land Conservation Program Manager, handed out maps and supporting information (available in County Board and County Clerk office) and responded to questions from the committee.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY SUPERVISOR VANDER LEEST AND SECONDED BY SUPERVISOR VANDEHEI TO APPROVE THE VARIANCE REQUEST. VOTE TAKEN. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Supervisor Vandei Hei excused at 7:19 p.m.

5. **PROPOSAL TO ALLOW BOW HUNTING ON BROWN COUNTY PROPERTY WITHIN THE GREEN BAY CITY LIMITS IN SCHMIDT PARK AREA IN 2007/2008.**

Jon Bechle reported there are still complaints about deer damage by residents in the Schmidt Park neighborhoods. Bechle provided a visual and pointed out on the map the areas proposed for bow hunting. The deer would be hunted by licensed and approved bow hunters throughout the City of Green Bay's authorized bow hunting program. The state bow-hunting season started September 15, 2007 and runs until the end of January, but the City can extend the season in specific areas until the end of April 2008.

Supervisor Erickson raised safety concerns, noting that the county might start building its new mental health center next spring in that county-owned area. There have been discussions of locating a dog park there and some dog owners are already taking their pets to that area.

Supervisor DeWane stated these are professional hunters in areas that need to be protected. There have been no incidents in the five years of the city program during which 331 deer have been harvested by bow hunters in the authorized areas.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY SUPERVISOR VANDER LEEST AND SECONDED BY SUPERVISOR FLECK TO APPROVE BOW HUNTING SEASON THROUGH THE END OF APRIL 2008. VOTE TAKEN. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

6. **DIRECTOR'S REPORT.**

Bill Hafs, County Conservationist, reported on the following items:

- a) The attendees of the Land Spreading of Wastes meeting on September 11, 2007 (attached). The information and rules provided at the meeting can be seen on the County Land Conservation Department website.
- b) Hafs shared a complaint regarding land application of waste in the Town of Eaton. DNR has permitted the land in which the complaint was filed to land apply 10,000 gallons of industrial waste per acre per day. The land applications of industrial waste occurred on the land and directly though an intermittent stream which is the headwaters of Scarboro Creek where DNR stocked 800 catchable trout in 2007. Land Conservation Department will work with the landowner to install buffers and obtain a nutrient management plan as required by state code and county ordinance.
- c) Hafs provided handouts (can be seen in the County Board and County Clerk office) re: Wisconsin: Inland Trout Fishing Regulations for 2007-

2008, Catchable Trout 2007 and Trout Streams and Land Waste Application Sites.

- d) Land Conservation department is advertising for a technician position to be filled as soon as possible.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY SUPERVISOR VANDER LEEST AND SECONDED BY SUPERVISOR ERICKSON TO RECEIVE AND PLACE ON FILE. VOTE TAKEN. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
